This opportunity is not limited to honoring only those buried at Resurrection; instead, it is open to all who wish to create an enduring tribute to someone dear to them.

A place of peace and tranquility

Each brick will be permanently placed in the patio area of the Peaceable Kingdom Garden, currently under development just outside Resurrection's Chapel Mausoleum. The idea for the Peaceable Kingdom Garden came from Mr. Antonio Pilla, inspired by his late wife Bonnie's love of nature and animals of all kinds. The Garden will serve as a place of prayer and reflection for any one who seeks comfort following a loss. Phase one of the development was completed in early 2011.
